Bordeaux and its region of Aquitaine needs people with a “four generation vision” to come and minister. Let me explain. Paul writes to Timothy: *“the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.”* (2 Timothy 2:2).

So Aquitaine needs relay runners – people who have received a message, and who live and preach this message, and who will pass on this message, but who will train others to pass on this message, too.

What will that look like, practically?

Evangelists: Aquitaine needs an army of straightforward evangelists who will explain the gospel in its streets, villages and towns. Otherwise the vast majority of people in this region will never hear the gospel explained.

Church planters: many large towns in Aquitaine of some 50,000 people have no gospel church.

Bible teachers and preachers: for people at all levels, from children right through to church officer training.

Teacher trainers: it’s no good being in a relay and not passing on the baton, so it’s vital that people are willing to encourage others into ministry and in ministry.

Lastly and mostly: people who love Jesus. It’s vital to love France and the French, and to love sinners, and to love the church, but in the end if you are going to spend your life serving here the only one really worthy of that commitment is Jesus himself.
